An online response tool that has been around a long time. What I liked is the ability to use short answer responses rather than creating a pre-designed quiz. The bonus is you can take those short answers and poll students based on their answers. Gives students time to respond in a safe place and get feedback from others.



Adobe Spark

Computer & iOS devices. Gives you the ability to create pictures, videos, & web stories in just minutes. Easy to transfer between devices. Drawn to this one due to the simplicity of creating the project and the ease of saving/posting. When creating the video a voice record option is easily used.



Talk and Comment Google Chrome Extension. Allows students & teachers to respond to text verbally. It records the voice and can add it into a Google Doc. Example shown: Checking for reading fluency or explaining a piece of text



Allows students to create videos showing their understanding over a concept. They post onto a class grid and students have the ability to comment and respond to their videos. They are on snapchat all the time, why not infuse it into their learning?
